Executive Director's Report

Ms. Short told the Board that she had drafted a letter to go to all licensees informing them that the board was no longer issuing wallet cards, they would only be receiving a post card reminding them to renew and not the application itself, and information regarding the new supervision regulation. The Board was in agreement that the letters be mailed but asked that the letters not go out until after the revised regulations went into effect.

An update on revision of the database was given by Ms. Short. She stated that she had begun meeting with the IT department with the Public Protection and Regulation Cabinet and they had prepared a "mock up" of the new system. She said that she was excited about the progress that had been made and that she planned to meet with them weekly so that she could provide boards with a status report each month. Estimated time of completion for the project is 10 months.
