Marriage and Family Therapy: 3 courses (9 semester hours).

Human Development: 3 courses (9 semester hours).

Psychopathology/DSM: 1 course (3

semester hours).

Professional Studies: 1 course (3 semester hours).

Research: 1 course (3 semester hours).

C. Practicum/Internship

Document completion of at least **300** hours of supervised client contact with individuals, couples, and families.
